Bed Supperclub is bringing two exciting names in music to town for two nights in a row. Tonight, Felix Da Housecat will set the dance floor alight with his blend of Chicago house and electro — and whatever else will make your feet itch. Tomorrow night will witness the eccentricity of Karl Bartos, for 16 years a member of [REDACTED].

Tonight won't be the first time that Felix Da Housecat has performed here — he once spun at the now defunct Ministry of Sound. Judging from that first foray on the Thai club scene, there shouldn't be any disappointment this time around. Felix Da Housecat understands the mood of the crowd and teases them accordingly, as only true mix masters are capable of doing.

Born Felix Stalling Jr, the tunesmith began making his name at the age of 15. From there, he went to carve out a global name for himself, manning his own respectable dance label, Radikal Fear Records. He has left his imprint on many remixed tracks from the likes of Madonna and Kylie. But many will surely remember him from 2001's *Kittenz and Thee Glitz*.

No introductions are needed for Herr Bartos, late of [REDACTED]. Though not a primary member, Bartos undoubtedly contributed to Kraftwerk's sonic blueprint. As one of the most influential music



groups in music history, most members of [REDACTED] remain enigmas and mysteries, but Bartos has been fairly active with various projects, including collaborations with Electronic and OMD, along with teaching stunts.

According to the press release, his initial deejay set in 1999 included "a mix of all-time electro classics and art sounds — the ignition for new live performance plans" which received much critical acclaim and which spawned a series of international dates. "Bartos 'live' combines the classic sound of [REDACTED] with his own pure electronic approach."
